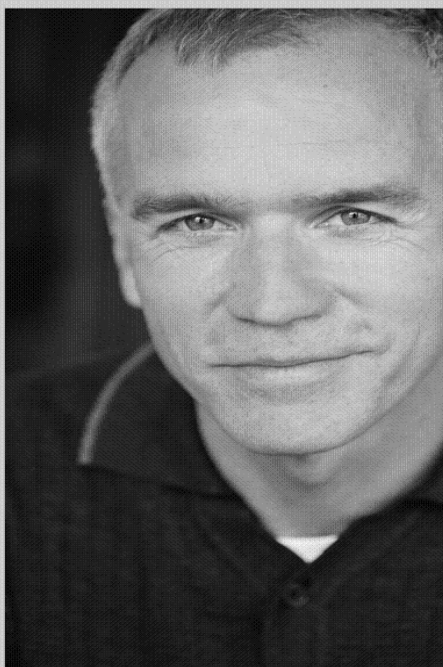

John was born and raised in Northern Ohio near Toledo. He received a Bachelor of Engineering Physics from Cornell, an MS in Physics from Catholic University of America, and his MBA from Harvard Business School.

In the ten years between Cornell and Harvard he worked directly under Admiral Hyman Rickover as a senior engineering manager at the headquarters of the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program in Washington, DC.

After receiving his MBA in 1972 he began a career in finance that included ten years as vice president in investment banking at Goldman Sachs and other NY City firms, eighteen years as financial consultant to independent power development companies, and the last five years in Houston providing customized financial strategies to help clients greatly increase the certainty of reaching their most cherished goals.

John is currently a financial advisor with Waddell & Reed in Clear Lake. He is a director of the Seabrook Rotary Club and a Trustee of its Foundation, a Director of the Bay Area Transportation Partnership, and Past President of the Guild for the Arts Alliance Center of Clear Lake.
